## YEAR 6 'CRUCIAL CREW' VISIT – CLASS 6A

As part of our Curriculum Studies this term we are taking the Year 6 children on a visit to the Lifewise Centre at Hellaby in connection with a Crime Prevention Project called 'Crucial Crew'. There will be a range of exciting activities for the children to participate in, arranged by South Yorkshire Police. The Lifewise Centre has put policies and procedures in place with regards to Covid-19; social distancing will be adhered to whilst on the visit and school will be taking a class on 3 consecutive days so that they are kept within their class bubble.

The content used in some of the scenarios is quite realistic and some children could become emotional when participating in or watching any of these.

Your child's class visit (6A) is planned for **Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> November 2020**. We will be departing from school at 8.45am and will be returning by the end of the school day at 3.05pm. ***There is no charge for this visit.*** As the visit is taking place at Hellaby, we will be walking there with the children. We have checked the route and carried out the necessary risk assessments. The walk also helps to promote the school's ethos of Healthy Schools. We do ask that children arrive at school for **8.30am** prompt to enable registers to be taken ready for a swift departure at 8.45am. School uniform must be worn for the visit and children will require a packed lunch.
